Footnotes

MORADOR LLERS (ARG) steadily advanced three to four wide on the turn, dueled through the stretch and outfinished his sparring partner late to just prevail in a head-bobbing finish. BRISTOL DANCER was allowed to settle into stride, steadily advanced through the opening quarter mile to then prompt the pace from outside, argued with ZIP IT NANCE on the turn, dispatched that one then dueled inside the eventual winner through the lane, was all out but just failed. HONOR'S GOLD was in a bit tight on the backstretch racing along the rail and steadied at about the half-mile marker, subsequently shifted outside foes leaving the backstretch, continued to angle out to be four wide at the quarter pole and five wide entering the lane, captured show while finishing evenly. STRONG FIRE was closer early vying for the lead between rivals, dropped back and then shifted outside runners the four path leaving the turn, lacked a closing rally. ZIP IT NANCE vied for the early lead racing off the rail, tired. BRINGCHECKCHARLIE showed brief speed, faltered, faded. BICO BLANCO was a step slow at the start then sent up between runners to attend the early pace, gave way.
