ETIQUETA settled off the early pace racing toward the inside, swung four to five wide leaving the turn to commence a rally, surged past in deep stretch under steady handling. SAVE YOUR PENNIES exchanged bumps with a rival at the start but was quick into stride to set a pressured pace inside, battled pace rivals into submission but was no match for winner late while drifting out through the lane. BABY GAVIOTA exchanged bumps at the start, showed no early speed bringing up the rear, angled inside foes in mid-stretch and closed well to just miss place honors. MISS BIKINI BOTTOM prompted the pace from between rivals, weakened in deep stretch. MISS PRIM tracked the vanguard along the inside, steadied slightly when in tight just after the five sixteenths pole, had no late rally. QUALITYFIRST attended the pace three to four wide, tired. LOTS OF MAZEL was hustled early to be forwardly place and part of the early pace issue between runners, dropped back and shifted out four wide at about the quarter pole, was empty in the lane.
