WROL UP dictated a soft pace, faced moderate pressure from AS DE COPAS leaving the backstretch and into the far turn, repulsed that one's bid then faced new pressure from LUIGI Q, dug in gamely to keep that rival at bay while drifting out slightly in deep stretch despite steady right-handed use of the whip. LUIGI Q was away alertly before setting into a stalking position in behind the early pacesetters, shifted out to the three path just prior to the quarter pole to commence a bid but could not reach the winner, steadied slightly just before the wire. VALERIUS tracked inside, was asked for more run entering the far turn, angled out leaving the far turn to be in the four path by the top of the lane, captured show. AS DE COPAS attended the pace two wide under a tight hold, drew closer on the far turn but had no late response and flattened out in the lane. LE MANS broke outwardly at the start, was relatively close early racing off the inside, weakened. LET'S FACE IT was no factor. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN, AND AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF THE #5, LUIGI Q, AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE #2, WROL UP, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
