Footnotes

PARTY LAD, close early between runners, was taken back and guided outside runners three to four wide at the five sixteenths to commence a bid, dueled through upper and mid stretch, prevailed. FLY SOUTH tracked inside, shifted three wide into the lane, dueled with the winner and yielded to that one late. ORSONIAN settled off the pace inside, shifted out four wide into the lane, captured show. STRONG FIRE made a mild bid four wide on the turn, weakened. ANTONACCI cleared the field and angled to the rail to set the pace, gave way in the drive. MORALITY chased the pacesetter in the two path, faltered, faded. SERAPI CAT steadied soon after the start, raced wide throughout while never threatening. HONOR'S GOLD raced in the second flight between runners early, steadily retreated.
