BICO BLANCO, away alertly, settled just off the pace to stalk the early leaders, began to move four wide leaving the turn, engaged in a long drive, wrested command by mid-stretch, had edged clear in deep stretch and just lasted to hold off the late charge of. DADDY AGAIN settled well off the pace, swung widest of all into the lane, gained in the six path and just missed. EMPEROR'S TUNE stalked four wide, altered course in upper stretch diving inside rivals, hit his best stride and was gaining late. EL TUSCANO tracked the pacesetter along the inside, shift out leaving the turn, was in the three path at the quarter pole, made a bid in mid-stretch, appeared to hang. KINVARA raced in the second flight between rivals for half a mile, had no late bid. RED MAX moved up inside rivals after the start to set the pace, extended the advantage down the backstretch, was challenged in upper stretch and wilted. HARD KNOCKIN ROBYN had no early speed, raced in the middle of the track well off the inside, never threatened. OMEGA RISING raced off the inside, was no factor.
