Footnotes

SCOOBY BAYOU cleared the field prior to the first turn, dictated the pace, edged away from his nearest pursuer on the turn, continued to widen in upper stretch, held the advantage down to the wire under steady handling while shortening stride noticeably. MR. TIGER bumped a foe a bit at the start, chased the winner throughout while off the rail, was all out in the drive but second best. EXUBERANT SONG bumped a rival at the start, settled mid-pack racing off the inside, improved position in deep stretch to get up for show. FIRST WON swung four wide for the far turn, gained mildly through the stretch to improve position late. GULF WIND tracked the leader inside, retreated. FOCUS POINT was bumped by inside and outside foes several times at the start but nevertheless close early and forced three wide on the first turn, weakened, tired. EL COBRE was bumped and squeezed back after the start, trailed throughout while in the four to five path into the lane.
