Footnotes

KAZACHKA, away cleanly, rated nicely just off and outside the leading pair, continued three wide within striking distance on the turn, drifted out a path leaving the turn, received steady left-handed urging through upper stretch then a couple right-handed taps of the whip in mid-stretch, was then put to a vigorous hand ride in deep stretch and responded by getting up in the final strides to prevail. AMERICAN PROUD tracked the early pace in about the two path, appeared poised to shift out and split foes late on the turn but instead was forced to wait behind and inside rivals when there was no seam available, angled sharply inside at the top of the lane when FANCY'S FIRST drifted off the rail leaving the turn, made steady progress through the drive, lugged out late, just missed. B L'S DREAM had no early speed, steadily advanced in late backstretch and on the turn, came off the rail to about the three path for the drive, split foes at the sixteenth pole and was gaining late but left too much to do and settled for the minor share. A LA FOLIE forced the pace, took command in upper stretch while drifting out despite steady right-handed corrections, yielded late. FANCY'S FIRST pulled against the rider's grip early on, set a pressured pace inside, drifted out leaving the turn, weakened.
