Footnotes

AINSLEY tracked the vanguard inside, dropped back off the pace and switched outside after the half, was put to a drive approaching the far turn, advanced three wide on the turn, continued to be hard driven and swept past in upper stretch, drew off while kept to task. DON'TCALLMECHARLEY settled off the pace early, advanced in a quick four wide move in late backstretch to apply pressure to the leader, dueled with that one around the turn, was confronted at the top of the stretch by the eventual winner, could not match strides with that one but was best of the rest. HORSIN' AROUND broke sharply and vied inside a three-pronged battle for the lead, dispatched those rivals midway down the backstretch but faced a new challenger in DON'TCALLMECHARLEY, dueled inside that one on the turn, weakened in the lane. LUCK BE THE LADY vied three wide around the first turn and down the backstretch, dropped back off the pace, heading into the far turn, angled inside on the turn in pursuit of the leaders then out a path through upper stretch in a renewed effort that just missed show honors. ROMEDIOS failed to menace racing just off the rail. BAMBOO STICK vied between runners for half a mile, faltered, faded.
