NILE TUNES, away alertly, stalked the pace outside rivals, advanced three wide on the turn, challenged for the lead at the top of the stretch, edged to a narrow advantage by mid-stretch under steady left-handed urging, maintained the advantage down to the wire while being kept to task late. GOLDEN GABY set the pace inside and clear, was engaged by the eventual winner leaving the turn, tussled with that one into upper stretch, yielded grudgingly but gamely fought on to maintain the place. SPA TOWN PARADE exchanged bumps with a foe at the start and then settled off the pace just off the rail, shifted out four wide on the turn and further still to be five wide into the lane, was steadily gaining late but had too much to do. SWINGING ENGINE had no early speed racing well off the rail with her tail swishing, swung six wide into the lane and belatedly picked up stride, closed fast but was too late. SCARLET DIXIE bumped a rival at the start, raced inside early, shifted to the three path mid turn for a mild bid but came up empty in the lane. MYTHIC prompted the pace two wide, shifted out a path late on the turn, tired. JAVAMINE was bumped by inside and outside foes at the start, chased inside, gave way.
