Footnotes

FLORIDA SUN was close early tracking the pace inside, dropped back on the turn, rallied up the rail through the lane, lost the whip inside the final sixteenth and surged late to prevail under a vigorous hand ride. GUDELIA set a pressured race just off the rail, was caught by the winner late while clearly best of the rest. TWINKLING TIME broke inwardly but nevertheless was quick into stride to press the pace, weakened in the lane. BACK WITH SUE was away mid-pack, angled out early on the backstretch, settled just off the pace, came three then four wide on the turn but had no bid. MAST HYSTARIA broke outwardly and bothered a foe a bit at the start, was forwardly placed to chase the early pace, tired. TOP NOTCH BLUE was bothered a bit at the start, trailed early, improved position while finishing evenly. JACKSON'S HATRIXIE failed to menace. OXIDIENNE was through early and retreated from mid-pack. A LITTLE SMARTIE never threatened.
