**Footnotes**

WAR COLONY, away alertly, rated off the early pace, moved three wide between foes on the turn, struck the lead approaching mid-stretch, edged clear under steady handling. FUSA CODE hopped at the start and was a bit awkward getting into stride, made a quick middle move sweeping to the lead four wide early on the turn, was clear and angled to the two path late on that bend, confronted at the top of the stretch by the eventual winner, could not match strides with that one but clear to be second best. REDEMPTION ROAD opened the gate but did not go through prior to the race, was close to the front after the start, came four wide late on the turn to move into third, had no rally but held show honors from. REVERE'S RIDE, who settled just off the pace inside, sought room but was blocked early on the turn, angled off the rail mid-turn, angled further in mid-stretch, was all out but could only finish evenly while inching closer to the show spot. CONGRATS CRIMINAL raced inside early, came off the rail on the turn and improved position. GULF WIND was wide throughout, forced five wide at the quarter pole, passed tiring foes late. KOLLOS threw his head at the start, was three then four wide while between runners on the turn. SAYYOURPRAYSNOW prompted the early pace, retreated. VANGUARD KNIGHT opened the gate pre-race, assumed the lead early, faltered, faded.
