Footnotes

BRISTOL DANCER was lightly bumped into the inside foe at the start, stalked the early pace, moved closer on the turn while three wide, vied widest in the three-pronged battle for the lead from the quarter pole on, took a narrow advantage inside the furlong marker and inched away from challengers late. FEARLESS COWBOY broke inwardly and bumped BRISTOL DANCER lightly, was content to stalk through the early going before drawing alongside the leader leaving the backstretch, dueled with that one on the turn then vied between runners when BRISTOL DANCER joined the fray, could not match strides with the winner late but secured the place from TRIP N RUN, who was placed on the front in the clear early, joined by FEARLESS COWBOY leaving the backstretch, continued to vie inside, yielded inside the final eighth. MORADOR LLEERS (ARG) was reluctant to load then got away a bit slowly, advanced between rivals on the turn, shifted out widest of all to the six path for the drive but had no rally. DUBAI DISTINCTION was bumped at the start, saved ground tracking the leaders, had no bid. SERAPI CAT was always back. HONOR'S GOLD was done early while four wide on the turn.
