**Footnotes**

A. J. RULER tracked the leading group under cover and just off the rail, dove inside at the top of the stretch, rallied up the rail, surged to the lead just inside the final sixteenth and prevailed under steady handling. PLAUSIBLY was caught three wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, moved up rapidly to force the issue after soft early fractions, continued to contend outside DEPUTY VIC into the lane, briefly put a head in front in mid-stretch but could not fend off the late bid of the winner. DEPUTY VIC entered the first turn two wide under a tight hold, came in ever so slightly entering the backstretch, inherited the lead when GRAN MISTERIO checked sharply at that juncture, continued to post easy fractions even while joined outside by PLAUSIBLY, dueled inside that one to upper- to mid-stretch, was joined then by the eventual winner from inside and vied briefly between runners before being outfinished late. COUNTRY MAGNUM bobbled slightly after the break, saved ground on the first turn, came off the rail entering the backstretch, made a bid three wide on the far turn to reach contention by the quarter pole but could not sustain the effort and flattened out. GRAN MISTERIO was away in good order and willingly on the front end, checked sharply entering the backstretch when perhaps in a bit tight as DEPUTY VIC came over just slightly, dropped back to last, shifted out on the far turn, was five wide for the drive but had nothing late. DIVINE MICHAEL raced off the inside around the first turn in hand, made an early move out three wide up the backstretch to reach striking distance, was between rivals on the far turn, weakened. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE TRAINER OF #1, GRAN MISTERIO, AGAINST THE #4, A.J. RULER, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE ON THE BACKSTRETCH, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN AND THE RESULTS WERE ALLOWED TO STAND.
