GRAND BAMBU showed speed from the outset, eased to the inside on the turn and opened a commanding lead, then was all out to hold off DECISIVE DAVID. The latter, unhurried early, raced four wide around the turn and closed well to gain the place. SWEET ROCKET MAN outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and found his best stride late to gain the show. MILE HIGH CITY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and tired. GUTS TO GLORY was not a factor. KAPTAIN HOOK off slowly, chased the pace along the inside into the stretch, then faltered. ECLIPTICALSWILDCAT saved ground and dropped back. SWEET DADDY D tracked the leaders off the rail to midway of the turn, then faded.
