LADY MYRKA reserved off the pace, rallied off the rail to reach the attending position on the far turn but couldn't match strides with the winner in the drive while holding the place. I CAN SEE MY DREAM unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to gain the show. LADY MAURA'S IMAGE outrun after lunging at the start, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened. MRS. SINATRA well placed while saving ground, steadied to avoid running up on FABULOUS CLEAR soon after entering the far turn and tired. IT'S A D'WILDCAT stalked the pace into the far turn and faltered. FABULOUS AND CLEAR set the pace along the inside into the far turn and faded.
