Footnotes

STRONG FIRE pressed the pace outside HEY BRAYDEN, took over from that rival at the quarter pole, then drew clear under pressure. BLANDISHING off slowly, tracked the pace, advanced three wide to loom a threat at the quarter pole but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while holding the place. MOTIN reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. BRIGHT KNIGHT stalked the pace four wide to the top of the stretch, then tired. B L'S A RUNNER broke poorly, stalked the pace along the inside to the nearing the top of the stretch, then faltered. IN SPEIGHT OF IT was no factor while racing four wide. HEY BRAYDEN set the pace under pressure along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then had nothing left. HIT THE CYCLE showed early foot, raced three wide around the turn and faded.
