LEXINGTON PEARL rated off the pace after being steadied at the start, circled rivals four wide to take over at the top of the stretch, then drew away under a strong hand ride. STARSHIP PLEASANT broke in bumping GOB SMACKED at the start, pressed the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. GOB SMACKED bumped by STARSHIP PLEASANT at the start, vied for the lead off the rail to the top of the stretch, then gave way. PRINCESS MALIA showed brief speed, raced three wide around the turn and tired. ARABELLA'S TUNE vied for the lead along the inside to the top of the stretch, then faltered. HENNY'S HURRICANE allowed to settle after being steadied at the start, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then faded in the final eighth. LOGAN SQUARE was outrun. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND THE RIDER OF GOB SMACKED LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF STARSHIP PLEASANT FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE AT THE START. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
