Footnotes

BROTHERS OUTLAW stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead at the sixteenth pole, then was all out to edge YA YA'S RULES to the wire. The latter, under stout restraint pressing the pace, hit the rail on the backstretch, then steadied when caught in tight entering the far turn, eased out and rallied to reach even terms for command approaching the sixteenth pole but was edged to the wire in a game effort. LIL JOHN PAUL set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, responded when challenged MARTY'S PERFECT on the backstretch, maintained his advantage to nearing the sixteenth pole, then gave way. EL COBRE unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention but had no further response. ROCKCASTLE saved ground and failed to menace. MARTY'S PERFECT stalked the pace, moved up racing down the backstretch to engage LIL JOHN PAUL, tried that rival into the stretch and tired. SIR SPARKY was not a factor. IM HAVING A BALL was outrun.
