MY ICE DANCER stalked the pace three wide, made a run to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then was all out to prevail. LADY MYRKA stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. LADY MAURA'S IMAGE vied for the lead along the inside to past the eighth pole, then weakened. AVADAY vied for the lead outside LADY MAURA'S IMAGE to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. HAPPY HANNAH unhurried early, angled out in the stretch and closed ground late without threatening. LOVE ME OR ELSE steadied from between rivals entering the first turn, tracked the pace, made a run four wide to reach the leaders on the far turn, then tired. MIA'S DOUBLE checked from tight quarters entering the first turn and was not a factor. BROOKLYN SOUND was outrun. AZISA rated off the pace, saved ground and faltered.
