Footnotes

DOUBLE REVERSE chased the pace off the rail, was floated out by CINDY CATA at the top of the stretch, gained the advantage from that rival at the eighth pole and edged away. CINDY CATA vied for the lead outside SILVER AND SMOKE, edged clear from that rival on the turn, then drifted out at the top of the stretch while maintaining her advantage to nearing the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. AFLEET MEMORIES stalked the leaders three wide into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with those rivals while holding the show. B L'S DREAM well placed early, raced four wide around the turn and tired. SILVER AND SMOKE vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, then faltered. BUSINESS DECISION broke a step slowly, showed some early foot along the inside and faded. MRS HALLIGAN was no factor after being steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch. MONEY ROUND off slowly, trailed.
