STAKES Calder Derby Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$150,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; \$35,000 or non-winners of two races other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter at a mile or over, 7 lbs. Preference; Graded stakes winners; Graded stakes placed horses at equal weights, then high weights. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Closed Saturday, March 31, 2012 with 36 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

GOOD MORNING DIVA was outrun for the lead around the first turn, chased the pace off the rail, moved up to gain a slim lead nearing the quarter pole, responded when challenged by BIG SCREEN soon after, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. BIG SCREEN stalked the pace three wide, moved up to engage GOOD MORNING DIVA at the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival and was edged to the wire. MUSICAL FLAIR off slowly, was rated off the pace, advanced around the far turn and into the stretch to loom a threat, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while saving the show. EL ROMANO unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention but couldn't sustain his bid and just missed the show. CSABA reserved racing along the inside, advanced to reach contention leaving the far turn, then tired in the drive. EMPIRE BUILDER tracked the pace, made a run four wide to loom a threat on the far turn, then faltered. LATE NIGHT ACTION outran GOOD MORNING DIVA around the first turn for the lead, eased in to make the pace along the inside to nearing the quarter pole, then had nothing left. SINATRA was never a factor. RAGING LION raced in striking position for a half mile and faded.
