SCARAMAGNA stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over in the stretch, then edged away under pressure. OUR MR. BUD stalked the pace along the inside, altered course outside the leaders in the stretch, then finished willingly for the place. BOB'S PLACE vied for the lead outside SEVEN KIND to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. SEVEN KIND vied for the lead along the inside to past the eighth pole and tired. LARGE KAUFY reserved racing off the rail, faltered in the drive. ISLAND SCHOLAR rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and faded. TWO IS TO MANY was no factor while racing four wide. VERO'S HERO was through after a half mile. WESTBOUND TRAIN allowed to settle, was taken up when he veered in and out entering the turn, then dropped back.
