ZIETE MACHOS rated off the pace, steadied in behind rivals and angled to the rail in midstretch, then rallied to be up late. INAGOTABLE set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while opening a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner late. TIZ MOE rated off the pace, advanced into contention four wide around the far turn, was outmoved into the stretch, then finished willingly for the show. ERUPTION ZONE stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. ALWAYSONTHEGOJOE stalked the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. TIGER'S ARGUMENT chased the pace off the rail to midway of the far turn and faltered. KEYNER VELOZ trailed after he dwelt at the start. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START.
