TWO IS TO MANY chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over racing down the backstretch, edged to a clear lead in midstretch, then was all out to just last over ARGENTINE TANGO. The latter, rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. MIAMI CAT stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch, then weakened. SKY VENTURE reserved early, advanced along the inside to loom a threat in the stretch, then tired. STORM WARNINGS raced four wide and failed to menace. TELL TALE FRIEND well placed early, raced three wide and faltered. HELLO PRINCE set the pace along the inside to midway of the backstretch, then faded.
