LOVE LETTER stalked the pace, rallied to catch DADDYS JEWEL at the top of the stretch, then edged away. IMPERIAL STRIKE rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then finished willingly for the place while unable to get to the winner. DADDYS JEWEL set the pace along the rail, opened a long lead racing down the backstretch, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then gave way. MISS MARTIN reserved off the pace after stumbling at the start, saved ground into the stretch but couldn't gain late. NAIGUATA raced three wide and failed to menace. TOPAZIO was not a factor. GOOD MOTHER FRAN was never close. LADY SAMURI was outrun.
