MEL BEACH showed speed along the rail, drew clear leaving the turn and into the stretch, then was all out to just last over STARSHIP WILDCAT. The latter, stalked the pace, angled outside the leaders leaving the turn, then rallied to just miss. TRIPSKI unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and closed well for the show. BIG RED TALENT pressed the early pace, chased the winner around the turn, then tired in the drive. DEFENSE MODE was not a factor. THE CHILL ZONE steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and was outrun. STARSHIP SULU chased the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered. CAY TO POMEROY saved ground to no avail.
