DUBAI DISTINCTION sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace, increased his margin into the lane and was kept to task as a handy winner. BRISTOL DANCER raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished with good energy. TRIP N RUN chased the winner from the outside throughout and gave way in the drive. MOTIN raced off the leaders from the inside throughout and finished with some late run. HARDTAP showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and passed tiring foes late. LANCE'S SONG was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. LIVIN LARGE raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. TWO MINUTE LICK was never far back, raced wide through the turn and weakened after going a half.
