GOLD STRIKE BEGINS set the pace off the rail, edged clear in midstretch, then was under steady urging to remain clear to the wire. POWER RULES pressed the pace three wide, then couldn't stay with the winner in midstretch but continued on with good courage to be clearly best of the rest. TOH'S GREY CAT tracked the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. SIR CHARLIE stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch but had no late response. INDIO ROOSTER up close early, tired. RUNYON HUMOR reserved racing along the inside, faltered in the drive. GUY ON THE GO very rank and taken up in behind rivals on the first turn, advanced into contention four wide around the far turn, then faded. NAVY WINGS was through after a half mile. DEVON ROCK off slowly, was outrun.
