DIXIE DEAR bumped with CASHMERE KITTEN at the start, chased the pace off the rail, rallied to take over leaving the far turn, then drew off under a strong hand ride. GRANDE CHICA set the pace along the rail to the past the quarter pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. LUCKY AND SWEET unhurried after breaking poorly, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals to be up for the show. CASHMERE KITTEN rated off the pace after being steadied when she bumped with DIXIE DEAR at the start, gave way after her rider lost her whip at the top of the stretch. RACHEL'S GIRL stalked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired. CAROLTEEN reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. NORMA CLAIRE chased the pace three wide to the far turn, then faded.
