BARRA D'ORO stalked the pace along the inside, bumped the rail and THREE PART HARMONY while moving through inside that rival to gain lead approaching the quarter pole, then drew off under urging. THREE PART HARMONY set the pace off the rail, then bumped with BARRA D'ORO on the far turn and was no match for that rival in the drive while continuing on with good courage for the place. PROMOVEDOR GLORY (ARG) chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then gave way. MASTER TASSEL reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach near even terms for command at the quarter pole, then tired. SOUTHERN GLITTER rated off the pace, faltered in the drive. PLUM CREEK saved ground and faded. ROOM MATE dwelt badly after hitting the gate at the start and trailed.
