Footnotes

DANDY ROSE set the pace along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and was all out to prevail. FOREVER DILIGENT rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, steadied when she drifted in behind DANDY ROSE inside the eighth pole, then was gaining on that rival along the rail at the finish. MARNESIA LIGHT reserved early, angled out on the far turn and closed to be up for the show. MASTER PROSPECT allowed to settle, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach the attending position, then tired in the drive. TUSCANY LIGHT chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and faltered. FAIR AND LUCKY was no factor after being outrun early. ADVANCED NOTICE showed early foot and faded. STARSHIP BULLETIN showed little while racing four wide. UNHURRIED steadied in traffic on the first turn and was done early.
