BEACHMONT FASHION unhurried early, circled rivals four wide to reach the leaders in the stretch, then gave way. BABY KING vied for the lead along the rail to the top of the stretch, then tired. HOPEFULLY LUCKY failed to menace. TRADER JOHN was outrun. UPPER SCALE showed brief speed and faltered. GARANHAO tracked the pace after bobbling at the start, then faded in the drive.
