LITTLE LAKE WIER outrun early, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole and edged away under urging. GOOD DANCING chased the pace three wide into the stretch, rallied to reach even terms for command nearing the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. AMBER RUN chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command approaching the sixteenth pole but couldn't sustain her bid. WORTH THE KISSIN quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to the sixteenth pole and gave way. SAVING GRACE failed to menace. JOSIE raced three wide on the turn and faltered. TOUR'S QUICK GAL was done early racing along the rail.
