**Footnotes**

SCORPION TIME reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, eased out in the stretch and rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole, then edged away. MORGANS BOY chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command approaching the sixteen pole but was outfinished. MR SUPER LIFT unhurried after ducking in at the start, rallied for the show. BIRDCAPER set the pace along the rail to inside the eighth pole, then was tiring when steadied at the gap in deep stretch. MARAL was saving ground when steadied in behind rivals on the far turn, dropped back to last, then improved his position in the drive. HE'S A SAINT off slowly, failed to menace. WAT prompted the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. GALLOPING THUNDER was not a factor. BOBS TIEBREAKER raced three wide and faltered. KADARKA broke open the gate just prior to the start nearly unseating his rider, raced in contention into the far turn, then faded. Following a stewards inquiry, KADARKA was declared a non-starter for breaking the gate open just prior to the start.
