LADY MARIAN LOUISE chased the pace three wide, rallied to engage JILLI'S TRIP approaching the quarter pole, took over soon after entering the stretch and edged away under pressure. JILLI'S TRIP set the pace under pressure along the inside into the stretch and weakened. BLUE DISTINCTION reserved early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. PERSONAL PINUP failed to menace. RUNAWAY JOAN was caught in tight early, moved up quickly to track the leaders four wide around the turn, then tired. ELUSIVE VACATION pressed the pace outside JILLI'S TRIP to midway of the turn, then faltered. NEED YOU TONIGHT well placed early, saved ground and faded.
