SHE'S A KETCH stalked the pacesetter, rallied at the quarter pole and drew even, prevailed through the stretch under firm handling. ANGELICA ZAPATA well placed and saved ground, rallied in the stretch and finished willingly. VENTANIA never far back early, angled out sharply in mid stretch and rallied. CATCH THAT KITTEN set a moderate pace, faltered slightly in the stretch. ACADEMICIENNE unhurried early, had a late gain on the inside. COFFEE RUN raced middle of the pack, lacked a late kick and went evenly. PETITE RIVIERE allowed to settle, failed to menace. EL BENDINAT contended while three wide, tired in the stretch. THE REAL FUTURE was never a threat.
