MISS VERMONT JET exchanged bumps at the start with TWINING GLOW, stalked the pace three wide, rallied to be just up under pressure. C. R. PACE pressed the pace early inside A WHEATIES GIRL, dropped back to angle outside that one nearing the quarter pole, gained command in deep stretch then just failed. SWEEP MACHINE was well placed while four wide and rallied late. A WHEATIES GIRL set a pressured pace outside C. R. PACE, drew clear nearing the quarter pole and gave way a sixteenth out. TWINING GLOW trailed after being bounced around at the start, then offered a mild late rally. TOURS VAL was off a step slowly, then never a factor while widest through the stretch. QUICKER KELLY showed brief speed after being bumped at the start.
