Footnotes

RACHEL'S DANCER reserved off the pace, came around EXCELLENT EAGLE in the stretch, then rallied inside SAVIANO to be just up at the wire. SAVIANO chased the pace, rallied to take over leaving the far turn and opened a clear lead, then just failed to last. BARLEY SUGAR unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the show. QUARTO AMIGO rated off the pace after hitting the gate at the start, swung out widest of all for the stretch run and finished willingly while being edged for the show. TOMS MULLIGAN allowed to settle, closed with a belated rally. FLY WITH THE WIND moved up around the first turn to track the pace, was bumped soundly by GENERAL LEDGER on the backstretch, continued to track the leaders into the stretch, then gave way. COUNTRY ACE was saving ground when steadied inside GENERAL LEDGER entering the far turn and failed to menace. EXCELLENT EAGLE set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then couldn't stay with SAVIANO and tired in the drive. GENERAL LEDGER well placed, checked after coming out and bumping soundly with FLY WITH THE WIND soon after entering the backstretch, checked again putting COUNTRY ACE in tight entering the far turn, then faded.
