ROMAN FROLIC dueled on the early lead, dropped back slightly on the second turn, came again in the stretch and prevailed after a long stretch battle. INAGOTABLE dueled early, gained a clear lead on the second turn, gave way grudgingly when hooked in the stretch and just missed. MASON'S MOMENT dueled early and pressed the pace with the top two, then gradually weakened in stretch run . TOTAL REWARD allowed to settle early, passed tiring rivals while no threat. TOUR DE COMPRISE never far back, lacked a late response after his rider's saddle slipped on the backstretch. YA YA'S RULES contended for three quarters, gave way in the stretch. EL COBRE slow early, was always outrun. SIR SPARKY was never a threat. ROCKCASTLE had brief foot and was through early.
