Footnotes

PEGASUS BELLE stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead outside SPELL AGAIN at the top of the stretch, then was fully extended to hold NOREENA THE GREAT safe. The latter, tracked the pace from the outside, raced three wide on the far turn, then made a run at the winner through the final eighth but wasn't good enough. JUST LARK outrun early, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to gain the show. MYSTERIOUS POWER reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and lacked a late response. WINNIEDAWHALE unhurried early, advanced into contention four wide down the backstretch, angled in on the far turn and tired. QUIXOTE'S PROSPECT well placed in behind the leaders, saved ground on the far turn and faltered. SPELL AGAIN chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the backstretch, angled to the inside when IDARETODREAM dropped back, then gave way in the stretch run. IDARETODREAM showed brief speed along the rail and faded.
