IRISH ROAD rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER vied for the lead outside LAUGHING LUKE, bumped with that rival entering the turn and edged away, then continued on with good courage while unable to resist the winner late. LOVE THAT MOON reserved early, angled out for the drive and closed to be up for the show. FORTUNATE BUY tracked the pace into the stretch and had no late response. SOURCE saved ground and failed to menace. BARNACLE STEVE unhurried early, lacked a rally. LAUGHING LUKE vied for the lead along the rail, bumped with RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER and steadied entering the turn, then faltered. FROLIC FOR JOY steadied from tight quarters in the early going, saved ground and was not a factor. STORM WHIRL trailed after being steadied from close quarters in the early going.
