**Footnotes**

ONAFROZENROPE vied for the lead from the outside, gained command midway of the turn, then drew off under urging. TROUBLE FOR TIGER allowed to settle after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the turn and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. JOHARLINGTON rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't keep pace with the top ones. RHYTHM IN MAY vied for the lead between horses, moved to the inside on the turn when STARSHIP WARLOCK dropped back, then gave way. NORWICH CADET chased the pace three wide into the turn and tired. I GO THROUGH failed to menace. DR. D R tracked the leaders into the turn and faltered. ONTHERAILWITHDAD was no factor while racing five wide. STARSHIP WARLOCK off slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead along the rail to the turn and faded. PROUD TRAIL showed little. DEPUTY DUKE was outrun.
