SUCCESSFUL MISSION stalked the pace, eased outside LITTLE NICK leaving the far turn, rallied to catch that rival inside the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to last over VOODOO SWINGE. The latter, reserved off the pace, swung wide for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. LITTLE NICK quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the hedge to inside the sixteenth pole, then weakened. FEELS ALL RIGHT (IRE) unhurried after breaking slowly, angled out in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. BLACK SCORPION rated off the pace while saving ground, closed with a mild response. MAMBO MEISTER allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. JACKSON BEND stumbled at the start, chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then gave way.
