TIA'S MISS rated off the pace, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run and finished willingly to just miss the place. FIRST INTERVIEW reserved racing along the rail, was blocked in behind the leaders on the far turn, eased out for the drive and couldn't gain late. LETTERS IN SILVER tracked the pace, made a run three wide on the far turn to reach the leaders, then gave way in the drive. MARNESIA LIGHT failed to menace. TIPPER KELLY M. D. set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then tired. MISS IDA BELLE was saving ground when she bumped the rail entering the far turn when caught in tight inside MARNESIA LIGHT, then faltered.
