KATE'S HOLIDAY reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead in the stretch, then responded when challenged by GOLDEN GROVE at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. GOLDEN GROVE allowed to settle after being caught in tight at the start, rallied to reach near even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed to the wire. SPIRITED WOMAN rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. RUTH WONDERS unhurried early, passed tired rivals in the drive. BEGIN AGAIN chased the pace along the hedge, slipped through inside SARATOGA BLITZ to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, then gave way in the final eighth. JUST A DREAM raced in striking position into the stretch but had no late response. SYLVIA TWICE chased the pace, made a run to join the leaders racing into the stretch, then tired. BLACK HONOR broke awkwardly, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then faltered. SARATOGA BLITZ set the pace along the inside, came out a bit at the top of the stretch and faded. PASSING clipped BLACK HONOR'S heels soon after entering the first turn and failed to recover. CATTY PATTY was

not a factor. DELINDA DELINE was outrun after being steadied in the early going.
