OUTWILD CATTIN rated off the pace, saved ground while advancing around the far turn, eased out in the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. SHE TIZ BOLD set the pace along the rail, increased her advantage in midstretch, then just failed to last. PERFECT BERRY reserved off the pace, saved ground, then responded to pressure in the drive and rallied for the show while unable to catch the top ones. MISS KITTEN tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch, then was gaining late. BLUE SAMURAI unhurried early, closed with a belated rally. ROSES FOR THE STAR allowed to settle, raced along the rail and gained some ground without threatening. LOVELY LEXUS steadied in the early going, raced three wide around the far turn and failed to menace. FLY BYE WILDCAT showed brief speed after breaking awkwardly, chased the leader around the far turn, then gave way in the drive.
