Footnotes

SURELY SENT rated off the pace, rallied to take over in deep stretch, then lasted over EMPTY HANDED. The latter, reserved racing along the rail, was caught in traffic in behind horses in midstretch, angled to the outside for room and was gaining at the finish. DANNY'S PRAYER tracked the pace along the rail, was forced to steady when caught in tight inside OMAR'S TIGER at the eighth pole, got through and finished willingly to be up for the show. ROAR OF THE SURGE stalked the pace, eased out and made a run at the leaders nearing the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. BULL HOLE chased the pace, moved to take over entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, then gave way late. PERFECT CHEROKEE allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the far turn but didn't do enough late. ICY STRAIT outrun early, closed ground late without threatening. OMAR'S TIGER set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired.
