BOND BARONESS chased the pace along the inside, eased out for the stretch run, rallied to catch SET THE TREND inside the eighth pole and drew away. The latter, off a step slowly, showed speed along the inside to past the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. GRAY FLASH rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to reach contention but couldn't keep pace in the final eighth. KEY WONDER appeared to buck jump at the start bumping with CUGATCHA, then steadied from tight quarters soon after and was not a factor. CUGATCHA bumped by KEY WONDER at the start, was done early. WHY I LOVE YOU chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then faded.
