KING OF SPORTS showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by TIGER entering the turn, vied with that rival to the top of the stretch, then drew away under urging. TIGER pressed the pace outside KING OF SPORTS, vied with that rival around the turn but was no match for that one in the drive. GOOD AND GRATEFUL chased the leaders three wide into the stretch, then tired. LET'S CONNECT rated off the pace after breaking a step slowly, faltered in the drive. CASHEL BACK was not a factor. MIURA well placed early, saved ground and faded. MAR BRAVO off a step slowly, was outrun.
