MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE rated off the pace, rallied four wide to take over at the top of stretch and drew away under urging. AMERICAN MISS tracked the pace three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. JULES FOR A. J. steadied in traffic on the turn losing good position, came out three wide and closed to gain the show. PROHIBIDO OLIVIDAR unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals in the drive. CODE OF JUSTICE set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch and tired. EXPECT AN ANGEL outrun early, raced four wide on the turn and was not a factor. COLLYMORE HALL chased the pace around the turn and faltered. ROSIE O' MALI showed early foot along the inside and faded. PAINTBALL was through early.
